List of materials for shown 17 inch circle bed:

- $\frac{3}{4}$ yard cotton fabric for sides
- $\frac{1}{2}$ yard fleece for top & bottom
- Sewing machine
- Thread
- Scissors
- Pins
- Fiberfill stuffing (medium size bag)


Note: you can also use other materials like corduroy and flannel. It's up to your own liking or your pets liking;)

Perfect for cats and small dogs!

This bed is reversible so you can use both sides! Make one with a summer and a winter side 😊


Instructions:

Print out the template without scaling and double check the 1 inch print scale. Cut around the perimeter of each page and piece pages together by matching the letters in the diamonds. Don't leave any room between pages and don't overlap. This is the finished half circle template:

Place the paper shape onto your fabric which you have folded over. For this bed I am using fleece on top and bottom. You need to cut out two circles. Align the straight edge of the paper shape with the folded fabric edge:



(my template got traced

onto other paper)

Cut around the paper shape. The following picture shows you how to increase the circumference of this bed. Simply cut around the paper shape with about 1-1.5 inch added. I wouldn't recommend it any bigger because it would create a problem when washing in a regular washing machine.

These are your two circles for top and bottom:



Cut now fabric for the sides. Cut 2 pieces of 44 inch wide fabric. I suggest to go with a height of 10 inches. Sew those two pieces with small sides together as shown (serge/overcast raw edge):

Cut this long piece now to the length you need. In case of you making a regular sized bed with the circumference as shown cut this long piece to 59". It should now measure 10" wide and 59" long.

If you are making a bigger bed and you added 1-1.5" to the circumference please measure the entire circle with a measuring tape to determine the length. Add 2 inches for seam allowance.

Pin the long piece of fabric with right sides together onto your top circle piece as shown. Pin all the way around making sure not to stretch the fleece.

This is how your bed should look like now:



Repeat with other circle and pin it onto the other side as shown.

This is how your almost finished bed should look like now:



Turn it inside out and stuff it to your liking. Less stuffing would promote a better wash/dry result! Lots of stuffing can take a long time to completely dry! Also, some pets prefer a more cushiony place to sleep instead of to firm.

Pin the opening closed and sew it either by hand or with your machine. Backstitch for durability.




All done!



Washing instructions:

This bed is fully washable in commercial washers. Use little detergent without softener because some pets are allergic against softeners. Dry on low heat!!! Dry at least 30-45 minutes. It might feel dry but moisture stays a long time in the center. If not dried properly and your pet lays on it the moisture will slowly creep towards the outside. It also would be more prone to make your pet sick! Prevent overstuffing in order to achieve a great drying result!!!






